

SPF Partnership with the Industry Safety and Security Watch Group (iSSWG)

he Industry Safety and Security Watch Group (iSSWG) scheme was introduced in 2008 to address safety and security concerns at the industry-level as the impact of a terrorist attack or any other disaster could affect the entire supply chain, thereby affecting the country's economic well-being.

With the formation of the iSSWG, Police can systematically engage selected industries on safety and security issues at a strategic level. It strengthens the ties between the police and industrial associations to fight crime and terrorism and promotes long-term collaborations.

The Chemical iSSWG formed in 2008, is one of the eight iSSWGs established in partnership with the respective governing industry associations.

As part of the long-standing partnership with the Singapore Chemical Industry Council (SCIC) to engage organisations / businesses from the Chemical industry, CPD has established regular platforms such as the annual webinar conducted during the COVID-19 pandemic to keep the chemical industry abreast of the latest regulations on explosive precursors, safety and security threats.
